Market Update

Equity

All 10 Ukrainian Exchange blue chip stocks ended lower on Tuesday (Dec 10) in line with losses in main European indices, as Kyiv's political standoff continued, with little common ground to be seen between opposition protesters and President Yanukovych. The UX index slipped 0.8% to close at 885 points. Leading the decline was Avdyivka Coke, which fell 1.5% to UAH 3.05; Motor Sich, CentrEnergo, and DonbasEnergo were each down 1.3%. UkrNafta and Azovstal saw more marginal drops of less than half a percent each and UkrSotsBank ended unchanged near 17 kopecks. Outside the UX basket, ZhytomirOblEnergo lost 7.1%, while heavy truck producer AvtoKraz gained 3.3% to 3.80 kopecks.


Ukrainian sovereigns were mostly up on Tuesday with Ukraine-23s improving by 1.2p.p. to 81.6/83.4 (10.6%/10.3%). Corporate names were down. MHP-15s and Metinvest-15s declined by 0.8p.p. closing at 98.1/99.3 (12.6%/11.5%) and 97.5/99.6 (12.9%/11.2%).



Riot Police Move in on Independence Square Protest Camp

Special Interior Ministry troop units moved in to dismantle a protest camp set up on Kyiv's Independence Square in the overnight hours of Wednesday (Dec 11). As of publication, the operation is ongoing and figures on arrests and injuries are not yet available. Around 3,000 people are believed to be occupying the camp. On Tuesday, President Yanukovych had met with visiting EU foreign policy chief Catherine Ashton and held a roundtable with his three predecessors, Leonid Kravchuk, Leonid Kuchma, and Viktor Yuschenko, but signalled no willingness to meet the protesters' key demands of signing a free trade agreement with the EU and/or dismissing the Azarov government. In response to this morning's events, Batkivschyna party leader Arseniy Yatseniuk (quoted by Interfax) said that millions of people will come out onto the street and that "the Yanukovych regime will fall".

COMMENTARY

We see a grave danger that in response to the government's move to clear the protest, the opposition will become more radicalized and may attempt to escalate the already-tense situation in order to deliberately provoke police violence. Yatseniuk has an unfortunate history of making over-thetop comments on which he is unable to deliver, and we doubt that the protesters, even in large numbers, have the leverage needed to topple the Yanukovych regime in a "revolution" scenario. At this point, it looks as though Yanukovych's engagement with the West is probably over; he has a year remaining as Ukraine's legitimately elected president, and having alienated the pro-European center of Ukrainian domestic politics, we expect him to re-focus on his core electorate of pro-Russian voters in southeastern Ukraine. This constituency is a minority of the overall national electorate but is not insignificant in size, comprising as much as 35% of the national voter base. We believe that, barring a U-turn on his EU policy, Yanukovych would have no chance to defeat a moderate pro-EU candidate in a national presidential election. However, given the rising instability, a Belarus-style scenario, in which Yanukovych relies on muscle from Eastern Ukrainian and/or Russian security forces to keep the central part of the country under his thumb. cannot be ruled out. In that case, a fraudulent election could be held and Yanukovych would remain in office for the foreseeable future.

UkrStat Revises GDP Decline from 1.5% to 1.3% YoY in 3Q13

Ukraine's GDP decline was revised from 1.5% to 1.3% YoY in 3Q13, according to final data from the State Statistics Committee published on Tuesday (Dec 10). On a quarterly basis, Ukraine's economy decreased by 0.3%, up from an initial reading of 0.4%.

COMMENTARY

The State Statistics Committee provided a detailed breakdown of the country's GDP by components that indicated a considerable decline of 9.0% YoY in capital investments in 3Q13. Meanwhile, consumer spending continued to support the economy, rising 6.7% YoY in the period, even as government spending fell by 3.0% YoY. Nominal GDP amounted to UAH 392bn (USD 48mn) in the period. We forecast that the country's economy will emerge from the recession in the fourth quarter, bringing the GDP decline to 0.5% for the full year.
